The Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022 has seen a significant increase in its penalties from the maximum of RM50,000 to RM500,000. The amendment has also put emphasis on entrusting organisations to “Self-Regulate” OSH at the workplace. Thus, organisations must strategically prepare, provide and sustain their OSH management blueprint to align with respective business operations.
