

Bosses all for online link-up with IRB

MALAYSIAN Employers Federation president Datuk Azman Shah Harun is in favour of employers going online with the Inland Revenue Board (IRB) to facilitate e-filing.

He said it will benefit both parties as they can at least expect to reduce their workload.

The federation will keep

in touch with the board, including holding meetings with it, to explore the problems that may crop up from such link-up and find possible solutions, *Sin Chew Daily* reported yesterday.

IRB director-general Datuk Hasmah Abdullah told the daily in an interview last week the board hoped to link up with employers so that the

the employers can fill in the income of their workers in their tax returns for a more simplified e-filing process.

Commenting on this, Azman said things are still at the initial stage and problems have to be overcome.

Once employers go online with IRB, they will no longer need to issue the EA form to their employees.
