
Introduction

According to section 29A (1) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994, any workplace in Malaysia that employs five or more employees shall appoint one Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) coordinator. Section 29(4) stipulates, failure to appoint an OSH coordinator will result in penalties not exceeding RM 50,000 or imprisonment not exceeding six months.
